— The Archeology Unit offers IE University students the opportunity to actively collaborate in our research projects. Our Archeology Laboratory is an ideal meeting point to learn in depth the activities, techniques and new technologies applied to the analysis and study of the archaeological remains recovered in the different excavations carried out by IEU.

— These practices will be developed in the 'Cauca Classroom' (Segovia Campus) two days a week, with a duration of 1:30 h. every day, from January to May 2020.

— The schedule will be adjusted to the availability of the students. No previous knowledge or experience is necessary.

— Research practices will be combined with the visit to the archaeological sites. They can be validated by credits and will serve as preparation to participate in our archaeological Spring or Summer camps.
